TERROIR CHARACTERISTICS

Flanked by rocky massifs, based on very poor granite soils, the Dão region, largely heterogeneous with regard to its altitudes, can easily reach 800 meters in height as well as descend to 250 meters. The vineyards, embraced by the surrounding pine forest, are divided into multiple sparse, often discontinuous plots with reduced areas. The mountains definitively condition the climate, serving as a shelter both from the direct influence of the continental climate as well as the influence of the sea winds.

VINES

Place: Sezures (About 90 years old)

Soils: Poor granites, at altitudes between 650 to 700 m
Varieties: Old Vines, 85% Reds Touriga-Nacional, Jaen, Baga, Tinta-Pinheira, Bastardo, Tinta Amarela, whites Encruzado, Bical, Gouveio, Uva-Cão, Barcelo, among others.

VINIFICATION

Grapes harvested by hand in the third week of September.
Full bunch, foot trodden in the lagar where the alcoholic fermentation takes place and ends at the French oak barrels, where it ages for 9 months.

ANALYSIS: 13 % Álcohol, 5,50 Total acidity, 3,59 pH.
