



TERROIR CHARACTERISTICS

Flanked by rocky massifs, based on very poor granite soils, the Dão region, largely heterogeneous with regard to its altitudes, can easily reach 800 meters in height as well as descend to 250 meters. The vineyards, embraced by the surrounding pine forest, are divided into multiple sparse, often discontinuous plots with reduced areas. The mountains definitively condition the climate, serving as a shelter both from the direct influence of the continental climate as well as the influence of the sea winds.

VINES

Place: Tazem (20 to 30 years old)
Soils: Poor granites, at altitudes between 450 to 500 m
Varieties: Encruzado

VINIFICATION

The grapes were hand-picked in the second week of September. Decantation was carried out for 12 hours after full grape bunch pressing. Total fermentation at the oak barrels. Ageing for 30 months. Batonnage for the first 6 months. 24 months sur lies.

ANALYSIS: 13 % Álcohol, 8,23 Total acidity, 2,95 pH.
